



The above Draught is a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Rockhill in the County of Bucks & State of Pennsylvania containing Thirty Nine Acres and One Hundred & fifteen perches and allowance of Six p^t Cent for Roads &c (being part of Seven Hundred & Eighty acres of Land that was formerly Surveyed for Dietrich Helzer in pursuance of a General Grant obtained by him from the Honorable Proprietaries of this Province about the year 1751. And was afterwards resurveyed to him by Virtue of a Warrant of resurvey Dated the 11th Day of June Anno Domini 1768) Now belonging to Henry Hambold, as will appear by a regular Chain of Conveyance now in his Possession - resurveyed at the request of the said Henry Hambold, December 28th 1805.
