We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that Robert Taylor is entitled to Two Hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the waters of Buffalo Creek to Include his settlement made in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy four.
