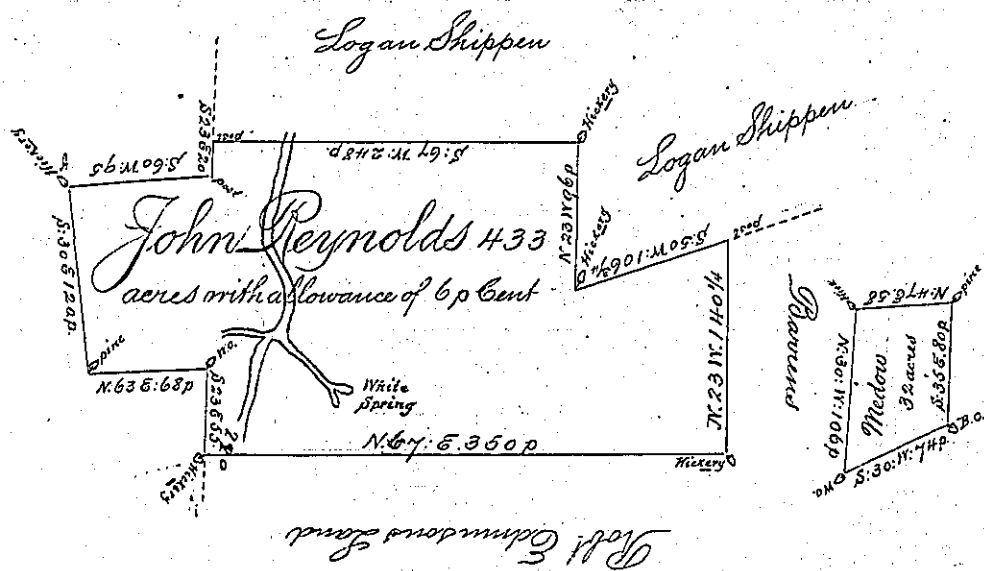

By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the sixth day of October Anno Domini 1738 I have Surveyed and Laid out unto John Reynolds in the Township of P^{er} Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the West side of Susquehanna river four hundred Sixty five acres of Land (in two Tracts) with allowance of six p Cent. One of which Begins at a Hickery at a Corner of Robt Edmondsons Land by the same Land North sixty seven Degrees Easterly Three hundred and fifty perches to a hickery. Thence Twenty three Degrees Westerly one hundred and forty perches and a Quarter to a Post in the line of Edw^d Shippens Land by the same Land South fifty Degrees Westerly one hundred and six perches & three Quarters to a hickery Thence North Twenty three Degrees Westerly ninety six perches to hickery Thence South sixty seven Degrees Westerly Two hundred ^{eight perches} forty to a post South twenty three Degrees Easterly Twenty perches to a post South fifty Degrees Westerly nine five perches to a Hickery South Thirty Degrees Easterly One hundred and twenty perches to a pine Tree North Sixty three Degrees Easterly Sixty Eight perches to a white Oak Thence South twenty three Degrees Easterly fifty five perches to the place of Beginning the other begins at a hickery Thence North thirty Degrees West one hundred and six perches to a white oak Thence South Thirty Degrees Westerly Seventy four perches to a black Oak Thence South Thirty five Degrees Easterly Eighty perches to a hickery Thence North forty nine Degrees Easterly fifty Eight perches to the place of Beginning
