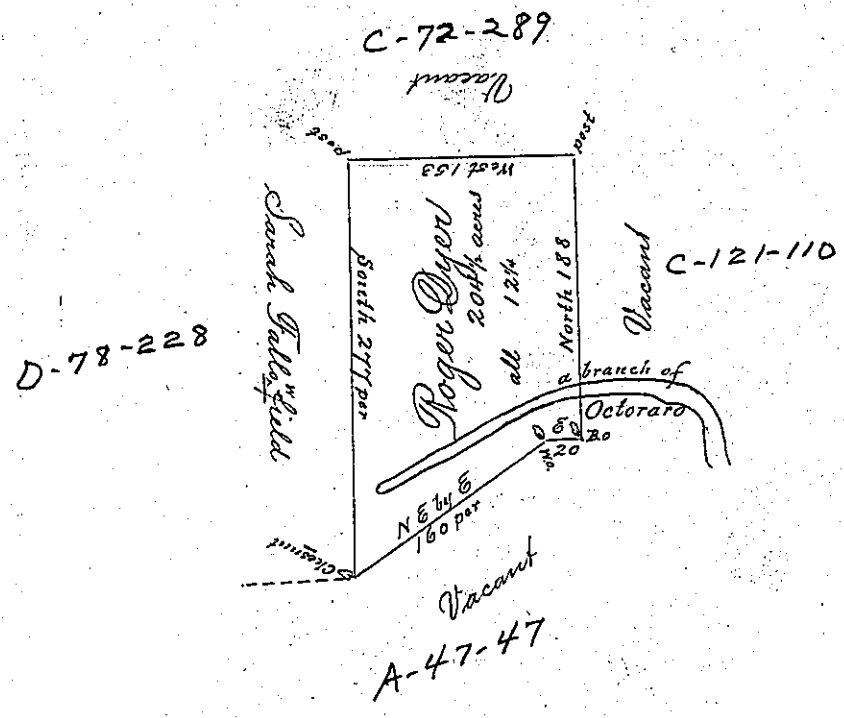

 a post thence west by the side of a Barren Mountain 153 perches to another post thence South by the Land of
 the s^d Sarah Tallorfield 277 perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing 20 1/2 acres with the
 usual allowance of 6 per Cent
 Survey'd 9th 2^d 1736 by Isaac Taylor
