



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 13th Day of June 1744 Surveyed to Henry Reser the two small pieces of Land above described the one Containing 16 acres and 113 perches beside allowance and the other containing 28 acres beside allowance the 10th Day of the 4th month 1756

By Warrant of the 5th Day of October 1743 Surveyed on the 10th Day of the same Month to Henry Reser the above Tract which joins the River Schuylkill containing 80 acres beside Allowance

By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 5th Day of October 1743 Surveyed on the 10th Day of the 4th Month 1756 to Jacob Reser the above described two Tracts of Land, the one Containing 168 acres and allowance and the other containing thirty seven acres and 118 Perches and allowance

The whole both Henrys and Jacobs situate in Bern Township now in the County of Berks
