



William Robinsons Land situate in Carnarvon township in the county of Lancaster in the province of Pennsylvania on A Branch of Conestogoe Creek Laid out by order of a Warrant Dated the sixth day of December Anno Domini 1738

Begins at A post thence south seventy Degrees West By Vacant Land one Hundred and sixty two perches to a post half A perch distant from A mark white oak tree thence north twenty Degrees West by Vacant Land one hundred and eighteen perches to A Hickory tree thence north seventy Degrees East by Vacant Land one hundred and seventeen perches to A Chestnut tree thence South forty Degrees East by Vacant Land one hundred and twenty two perches to the place of Beginning Containing ^{Land} ~~containing~~ ^{seven} ~~seven~~ acres and all the same Surveyed the fourth Day of January Anno Domini one thousand and seven hundred and thirty eight - *Francis Wayne*
