



A draft of a tract of land situated in the township of Juniata (formerly Walker) in the County of Huntingdon, containing forty-one and one-half acres and allowance of six per cent First surveyed on the 1st day of June, 1848, in pursuance of a warrant granted to J. Simpson Africa, dated the 18th day of May, 1848, and re-surveyed on the 24th and 25th days of November, 1863, under the direction of John A. Collock, Esq., then County Surveyor, in pursuance of an Order of Re-survey granted to said J. Simpson Africa by the Board of Property on the 16th day of July, 1852. The field notes of said re-survey I have this 23rd day of April, 1867, examined, found correct and approved.
