By Order of the Proprietaries Surveyed to Robert Buchanan in the Township of Donegal & County of Lancaster a Tract of Land Beginning at a Black Oak in the Line of Ephraim Moor's Land thence North 65 deg East 138 perches to a post thence North 25 deg West 20 perches to a post thence North 65 deg East 163 perches to a post thence North 20 deg West 22.6 perches to a white oak thence South 60 deg West 151 perches to a black oak thence North 30 deg West 20 perches to a white oak thence South 60 deg West 169 perches to a hickory thence South 25 deg East 238 perches to the place of Beginning Containing four Hundred & twenty five acres with the Allowance of six acres p Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 11th of May 1737.
