We the Commissioners for Adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Thomas Ammor is intitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania situate on the Waters of Raccoon to include his improvement made in the year 1774 Given under our hands at Cox's Fort the fourth day of February 1780 & in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
