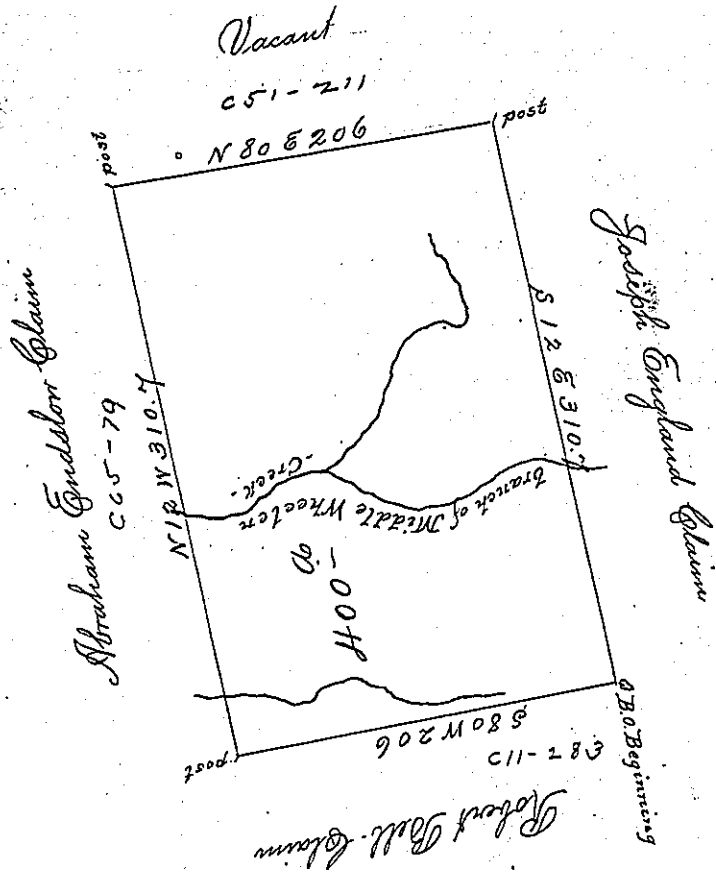

The above is a draught of survey made August 29<sup>th</sup> 1785. On Certificate granted George Atkinson Dated January 18<sup>th</sup> 1780. Called For. Tract Containing 400 acres - and is situate in Washington County. - A True Copy - viz: We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that George Atkinson Afs<sup>o</sup> of Ebenezer Osborne is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in Ohio County on the Middle fork of Wheelers to include his actual settlement made in the Year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy Three.

Given under our hands at Conesfort the eighteenth day of January 1780. in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
