



Survey of a tract of land situate in the Township of Middletown Delaware County Bounded and described as follows viz: Beginning at a stone in a line of Samuel Kibberd's land and a corner of Aaron Malin's land, thence by the said Aaron Malin's land North fifty two and a quarter degrees East Three hundred and fifty nine perches to the Middle of Pridley Creek, passing over a stone set on the Bank of said Creek, thence up said Creek the several courses thereof Eighty six perches and sixty four hundredths of a perch to a corner of Joseph Edward's land thence by the said Joseph Edward's land passing over a stone on the west bank of said Creek South fifty one and a half degrees West one hundred and forty eight perches and seven tenths of a perch to a stone a corner of William Smedley's land thence by the said Smedley's land and by land of Isaac Chalfant and Mrs. King South fifty two and a half degrees West Two hundred and forty seven perches to a stake in the middle of the State Road, thence along the middle of the said State Road South Eighty two and a half degrees West Twenty eight perches to a Bridge over a small stream, a corner of said Samuel Kibberd's land thence by the said Samuel Kibberd's land South forty two degrees East Sixty four perches and four tenths to the place of Beginning.
