



The above Draught represents a Tract of Land on the West Branch of Octorara Creek situate in Colerain & Little Britain Townships Lancaster County containing 408 acres & 100 perches & allowance of six per cent being a part of an Original Tract of 408 acres & allowance which was surveyed & Returned to the Land Office to John Walker. Including three different warrants one Tract of about 167 acres & allowance which was surveyed for John Barclay the 17th of the 2 month 1737 by warrant of the 13th of May 1736 which survey was afterwards possessed by Nichibald White who obtained two additional warrants the first for 50 acres more or less dated the 1st of February 1748 & the other for 30 acres more or less dated the 8th of August 1749; and sold his right of the whole to the said John Walker for whom the 2 last mentioned warrants were executed the 7th of the 11 mo 1753 & 4th of the 3 mo 1754. Surveyed January 18th 1842
