



A Draught of a Tract of Land, situate in Hopewell Township in the County of York, Surveyed the 14th of the 5th month 1794 by William Kersey late Deputy Surveyor (and by him neglected to be returned) for William Perkepille and Andrew Perkepille In Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to them for 50^a bearing date the 17th day of June Anno Domini 1793 Containing as above set forth twelve acres and one Eighth and the allowance of Six per Cent & c And now at the request of Andrew Perkepille above named, we are desired to make return of the Draught, the 5th day of July Anno Domini 1803
