



The above is a Draught of a survey made on the 21st and 22^d days of November A.D. 1811 for George A. Bayard Esq. situated on the River Allegheny in Peebles Township, Allegheny County (It appears to be part of the middle tract of an original survey of Three Tracts of land, containing in the whole 1352 1/2 Acres and 39 perches and allowance of 6 per cent - and the original survey of this tract calls for 186 Acres 133 ps and allowance - and appears to have been surveyed on the 26th and 27th days of June 1769 for George Cragham Esq. on his Special Application No 20 by Robert McCrea Esq. D.S.) containing one hundred and seventy one acres and one half of an acre, and five and one half perches and allowance of 6 per cent for Roads, &c.

Note: The balance of this tract, marked "A" was surveyed by Stephen Woods Esq. D.S. June 8th 1838, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Young Esq. for 39 acres dated April 10th 1838 and marked as containing 39 acres and 35 perches and allowance of 6 per cent &c.
