



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York, Containing within the black lines as above set forth 51^{ac} & 129^{ps} & allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of 268^{ac} and allowance, which was Originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 2^d of the 4th mo. 1770. for Stephen McKinley in pursuance of two Warrants, one granted to Richard Mc Donnell for 100^{ac} dated the 22^d day of March 1743. the other granted to David McKinley for 50^{ac} dated the 1st day of April 1751. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land at the instance of Thomas McKinley the present owner on the 2^d day of April 1821.
