Which was originally Surveyed on the 8th & 9th days of March 1750 by George Stevenson late D.S. and recently on the 25th day of the 11th month 1775 by William Kersey late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant for 100[£] granted to Leonard Mifflin bearing date the 15th day of February 1749. Since divided &c. Now on the 24th day of October A.D. 1786 I Examined & Corrected the above &c. at the request of Elias Folkomer the present owner, Who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation and having the same Patented.
