Surveyed for Samuel N. Snow, John P. Brumbaugh and Eli Brumbaugh the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1861. Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Embriken Jr. dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1845 and Reexamined and found correct the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September A.D. 1870.
