



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York, Containing 9^{ac} & 10^{1/2} perches & allowance &c. Part of 274^{1/2}^{ac} & allowance &c. Which was originally Surveyed on the 22^d day of October 1751 by George Stevenson later D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} granted to Peter Ringale, bearing Date the 10th day of September 1750. Since divided &c. Now on the 27th day of December A.D. 1837. Examined & Corrected the above &c. at the request of John Zorbach, the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation per D. Lees D.S.
