



Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Lower Windsor Twp. York Co. Penna. containing 179 acres & 158 perches & allowance, being composed of parts of five different Warrants, to wit: Part A containing 54 acres & allowance being part of 70 acres & 131 perches, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert Bingham dated March 11 1789. Part B containing 64 acres & 22 perches & allowance being part of 212 acres originally surveyed on Warrant granted to Jacob Jacobs dated May 15 1752. Part C containing 50 acres & 80 perches and allowance being part of 110 acres originally surveyed on Warrant granted to James Strong Sen<sup>r</sup> & James Strong Jun<sup>r</sup> dated March 16 1790. Part D containing 10 acres & 104 perches and allowance being part of 43 acres & 60 perches originally surveyed on Warrant granted to Kraft Hermil dated March 13 1793 and part E containing 112 perches and allowance being part of 35 acres & 75 perches (W<sup>t</sup> 40 acres) originally surveyed on Warrant granted to Thomas Armor dated March 7 1776. Surveyed Oct 4 1864 at the request of Michael M<sup>c</sup>Guigan present owner by D. Strickler for Benj<sup>n</sup> Leese D.S.
