One surveyed to William Brodhead on a warrant dated August the 25th A.D. 1851, the other to Charles Ridgway on Warrant dated the 9th day of September 1816, showing interferences; that the Charles Ridgway tract being the older tract, and Patented, covers thirty four acres and one hundred forty three perches and allowance of six per cent of land, included in the William Brodhead Survey, both lots being in Lehman Township.
