Part B was originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benj Cuningham dated the 16th June 1798. Part C was originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benj Cuningham dated the 29th day of June 17th (abt) Part D containing 10^{as} & allowance surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert I Cuningham and Benj F. Cuningham for 10^{as} bearing date the 18th day of February 1852. On the 15th & 16th days of April 1852 resurveyed the whole and protracted in one plot at the request of Robert I. Cuningham Benj F. Cuningham & Stephen W. Cuningham the present owners to make return thereof for Confirmation
