



A Draught of a Lot or piece of Ground Situate on the East side of Sixth Street from Delaware in the City of Philad^a between Walnut & Spruce Streets at the distance of three hundred & twenty feet from Walnut Street and Extending in Breadth Southward along the East side of Sixth Street One hundred and three feet and in depth One hundred and ninety nine feet or one half way to Fifth Street; Bounded Westward by Sixth Street aforesaid, Southward by a new Street of Forty Six feet in Breadth called Pruan Street; Eastward by Vacant ground, and Northward by other ground heretofore granted to the County Commissioners. Surveyed the 31st day of October 1774 for the Commissioners of the County of Philad^a. In pursuance of a Warrant to me directed bearing date the 29th of the same Month. In order to Erect thereon a New Goal, Workhouse and House of Correction. Return'd into the Secretaries Office the 20th day of December 1774
