Containing in the whole sixty nine acres fifty four perches and the usual allowance of six p^r Cent. 67^{ac} 154 Pr^s being part of 250 acres. originally Surveyed on Warrant granted Samuel Baker dated the 31st of 10th m^o 1701 as part of George Whites original purchase of 2500 acres, and 1^{ac} 60^{pr} the remaining part thereof being part of 200 acres Originally Surveyed on Warrant granted John Rowland dated the 31st of 10th m^o 1700 both tracts resurveyed to George Haworth on the 27th of 3rd m^o 1702 by John Culler. Surveyed off for Cyrus Betts August the 16th 1836
