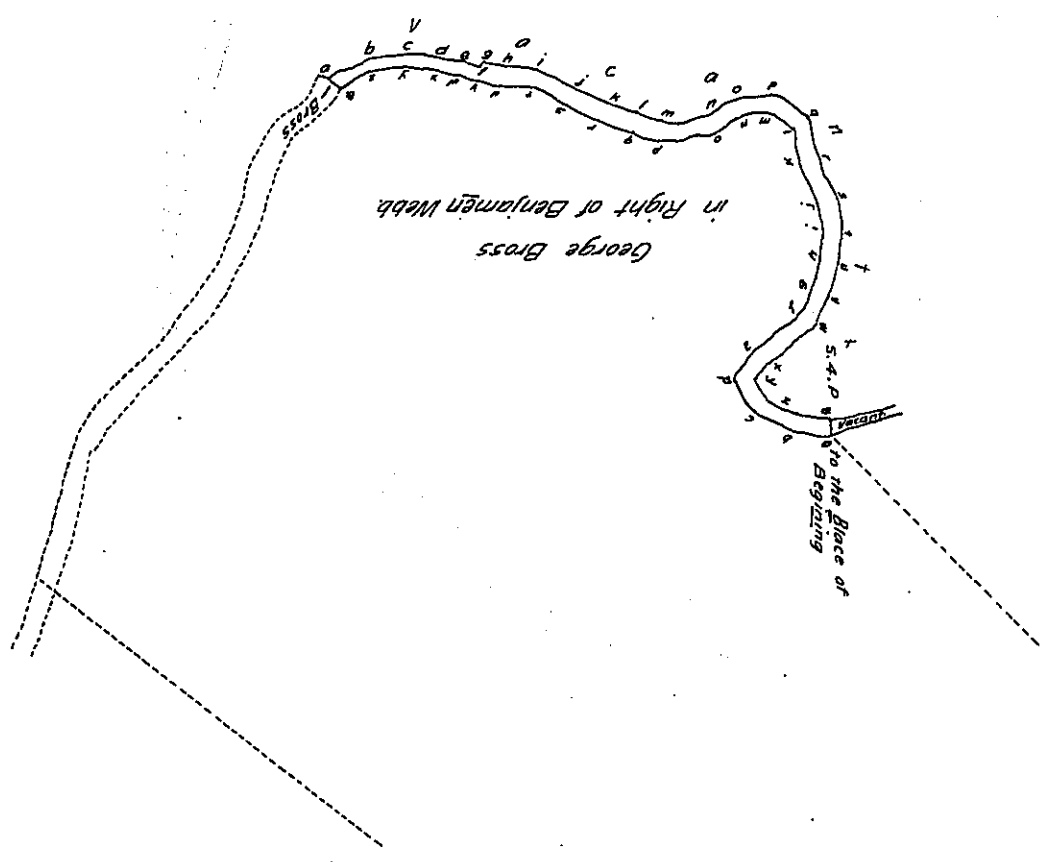

Whereas July 22nd 1874 an explanation about the Swadara Creek as fair as George Cross applied for 5 acres 49 perches is only part of the vacant Land then the Swadara - never was any application taken out and the Distance Crossing the Creek is 8 perches George Cross application is on the South Side along as fair as his Land goes the Tract is the Cours Given in Benjamin Webb Cours or tract 1737 Since that time the Swadara - Shifted Different Courses all on the north Side a good deal more then the Width of the Creek on some places Depriving him having Excess to the Said Creek.

the Survey was made for Benj Webb Down the Swadara Creek 232 perches on the South Side then Crossing ^{north side} the Rudolph Huntsacres Survey was made 1742 on the north Side of Said Creek and Down Said Creek and principally on huntsacres Land and on some places the Line is on the South Side of the Creek where it is the Swadara - Runs now
