We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the Counties Yohogania Monongahela and Ohio do hereby Certify that James Bradin is Intitled to four hundred acres of land in the County Monongahela on Ten Mile Creek to Include his actual Settlement made in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy two.
