



The above Draught describes two tracts of land in Juniatta Township Perry County (formerly Rye Township & Cumberland County) The upper one originally Survey^d in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 8th Sept. 1766 No. 1155. Granted to John Murray containing 144 acres 2^{ps} and allowance; The other adjoining Tract was Survey^d on a Location to David Miller dated 2 Sept 1767 No. 4344 (as appears by our copy from Land office) containing 340 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres. And now resurvey^d the above coloured part for the present owners and parties in interest to wit William Bull who owns the west end of both tracts, and the Heirs of Henry Bull the middle part of said tracts and the eastern end in dotted lines is the remainder owned by the heirs of Joseph Smith not now applied for
