Beginning at a stake for a corner of Land lately Survey'd unto Michael Freytag thence by the same S 81° E. 20 P. to the low water mark of Schuylkill River or to the line that wharfs may lawfully be extended thence down the River S 8 3/4 W. 9 P. to a corner thence by Land of the City Corporation N 78° W. 20 P. to a corner on the East side of the madow bank thence by the same N 8 3/4 E 8 P. to the beginning
