



A Draught of a tract of Land situated in Northham Township in the County of York, containing one Hundred and Twenty Acres, and the Allowance of Six Acres per Cent. for Roads and Highways; One Hundred and Thirty Five Acres, part thereof is part of a larger tract of Two Hundred and Seventy Acres Survey for Conrad Berkhaver, by Zachariah Deucher in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 3^d Day of October 1758, and Fifty Five Acres the Residue of the said One Hundred and Twenty Acres, Surveyed the 6th Day of November 1757 for the said James Kölller by Virtue of a Warrant Granted unto George Berkhaver, and bearing Date the 6th Day of August 1753. The Right of both which Pieces of Land is said to be vested in or Bargained and sold unto the said James Kölller, at whose Request I have Surveyed the said Two Pieces into one Tract and that by the ancient Lines thereof, as the same had been formerly Surveyed by George Stevenson
