



Situate in Windsor township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 114as. & 92ps. & allowance, Being part of a larger tract of 325 1/4 as. & allowance, which was originally Surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 2d. of the 1st. month 1793, in pursuance of a warrant for 300as. granted to Alexander Henderson bearing date the 9th day of April 1776, and afterwards to wit on the 13th. day of September 1796, Resurveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 6th of April 1795, and now on the 30th. day of April 1819. Resurvey by the Old lines and divided off from the said larger tract, at the instance of Matthias Becker & George Overdorff the present owners, who desire the same to be returned for confirmation.
