



The above is a Draught of a Survey made August 6th 1827, for Dr. Samuel Murdoch (agent for Dudley Woodbridge of Ohio) situate in the fork of Charter's Creek in Straban Township W. G. Containing two hundred and seventy acres, and 88, perches, and Allowance of six pr. Cent being the same that was lately partitioned and set apart to Dudley Woodbridge out of a body of lands called Morganz — The above Survey is composed of part of two original Surveys, The Compartment marked A, is a part of a tract of land granted to Paul Fooks in pursuance of an Appl. No. 1916 dated April 3d 1769 Containing 132 Acres, the whol tract containing 288 acres and 120 perch on the west side of the Monongahela River — The Compartment marked B, Contains 154 3/4 acres, and is a part of a tract of land granted to David Evans, in pursuance of an Appl. No. 1969 dated April third 1769, Containing 201 acres and 140 perches situate on the west side of the Monongahela River.
