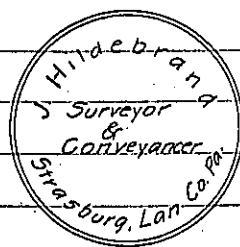

The one containing 13a. & 3 perches and usual allowance &c. being a part of 210 acres & all, on Warrant granted to Peter Lawrence, December 21st A.D. 1750. The other two pieces containing together 37a. & 156 per. & all, &c. being a part of 54 acres & all, &c. on Warrant granted November 7th A.D. 1755, to Jacob Grundle. Resurveyed May 1st A.D. 1873, for Michael Winters and Thomas & Peacock.
