The above mentioned return of survey of said larger tract ought to have stated that it was made by virtue of two Warrants granted to Andrew Hannah to wit the above mentioned Warrant and one dated the 9th. day of November 1750 (the last mentioned being perfectly descriptive) instead of returning it on the warrant latest in date the same being also bounded by the land intended to be covered by the said Warrant of 1750. — from the most correct information that I can obtain Andrew Hannah owned no other land in the then Township of Paxtang except the tract above mentioned.
