

*And now, to wit, March 24, 1902, the within survey is accepted and the patent to be granted, the note on the survey being disregarded for the following reasons: First, that under the decision of the Board of Property a warrant under the Act of 1848 does not pass the fee simple, but conveys only a mining right; and second, that under the decision of the Board of Property the warrant to D. J. Kyle and others is a nullity, no authority existing at the time said warrant was granted to grant warrants in fee for the bed of a navigable river.*
