



To all to whom these presents may concern, I, John Schall of West Brunsw<sup>e</sup>ig Township in the County of Schuylkill and State of Pennsylvania, do hereby certify, - That whereas a Warrant was granted unto William Hughes on the twenty ninth day of May, 1752, (for Twenty five Acres of land, on the below Isaac Cauffmans, on the West Side of Schuylkill) <sup>in Brunsw<sup>e</sup>ig Township, Berks County,</sup> by virtue of which said Warrant, it appears, that there was afterwards Surveyed a tract of land containing 120<sup>a</sup> 145<sup>p</sup> & allwa at the place, described in the Said warrant, but not Returned into the Office. - And whereas it now appears, that the Said William Hughes, afterwards took the Said Warrant and laid the Same by a Survey, made for it, on an other tract of land in the Said township of Brunsw<sup>e</sup>ig, and County of (then Berks - now,) Schuylkill, and Surveyed on it about 70<sup>a</sup> 120<sup>p</sup>. & allow. and held the Same. - And whereas also a Warrant was granted unto one John Zug, dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, A.D. 1787 - by virtue of which Said last Warrant, a Survey was made on the Same tract of land, which was first Surveyed, unto the Said William Hughes, by the first above recited warrant, and which Survey was afterwards abandoned by the said Hughes, and the Said Survey made for the Said John Zugs Warrant was afterwards Returned into the Surveyor Generls Office, and confirmed. I the Said John Scholl do hereby declare, that I do hold the Said tract of land, under the Warrant of John Zug, as Surveyed for him, and Returned, and not by the warrant under the Said William Hughes. all these Several Office Rights can be seen in the Surveyor Genls Office reference being thereto had.
