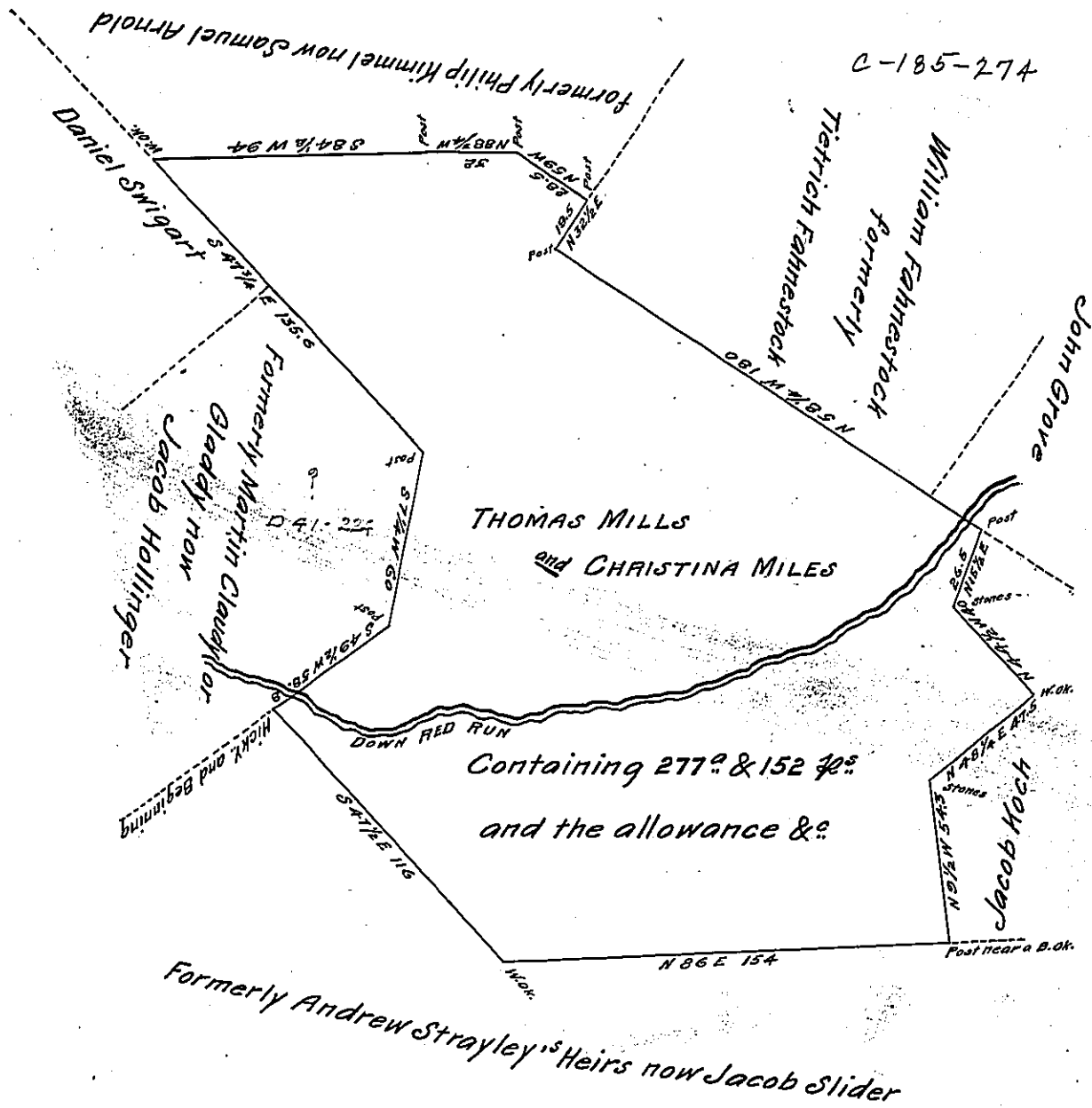

Situate on the west side of the Susquehanna River in Washington Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 277-^a & 152 perches and allowance of six Per Cent &c Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. In Pursuance of two Warrants one Granted to Thomas Mills for 100^a dated the 24th day of October A.D. 1743, and the other Warrant for 50^a Granted to Christina Miles for 50^a dated the 5th day of November 1748, And afterwards Resurveyed in pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey Granted to Jacob Kimmel and Michael Kimmel dated the 27th day of February 1765. Resurveyed by the old lines, on the 2^d & 3^d days of April A.D. 1811, at the request of the Present owner George Beck, who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
