We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio, do hereby Certify that John Moore is intitled to four hundred acres of Land on Dunlap's Creek in the County of Monongalia to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy. Given under our Hands at Redstone old fort the Seventeenth day of December 1779, in the fourth year of the Common-wealth.
