



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 31st 1817 containing 275 & $\frac{3}{4}$ and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c in pursuance of a Warrant granted John Joins bearing date the 2nd day of December 1784. Situate in Whately Township Greene County on big Whately Creek called "Evans."

The above survey made agreeable to old lines which were run by Thomas Duglas about the year 1785.
