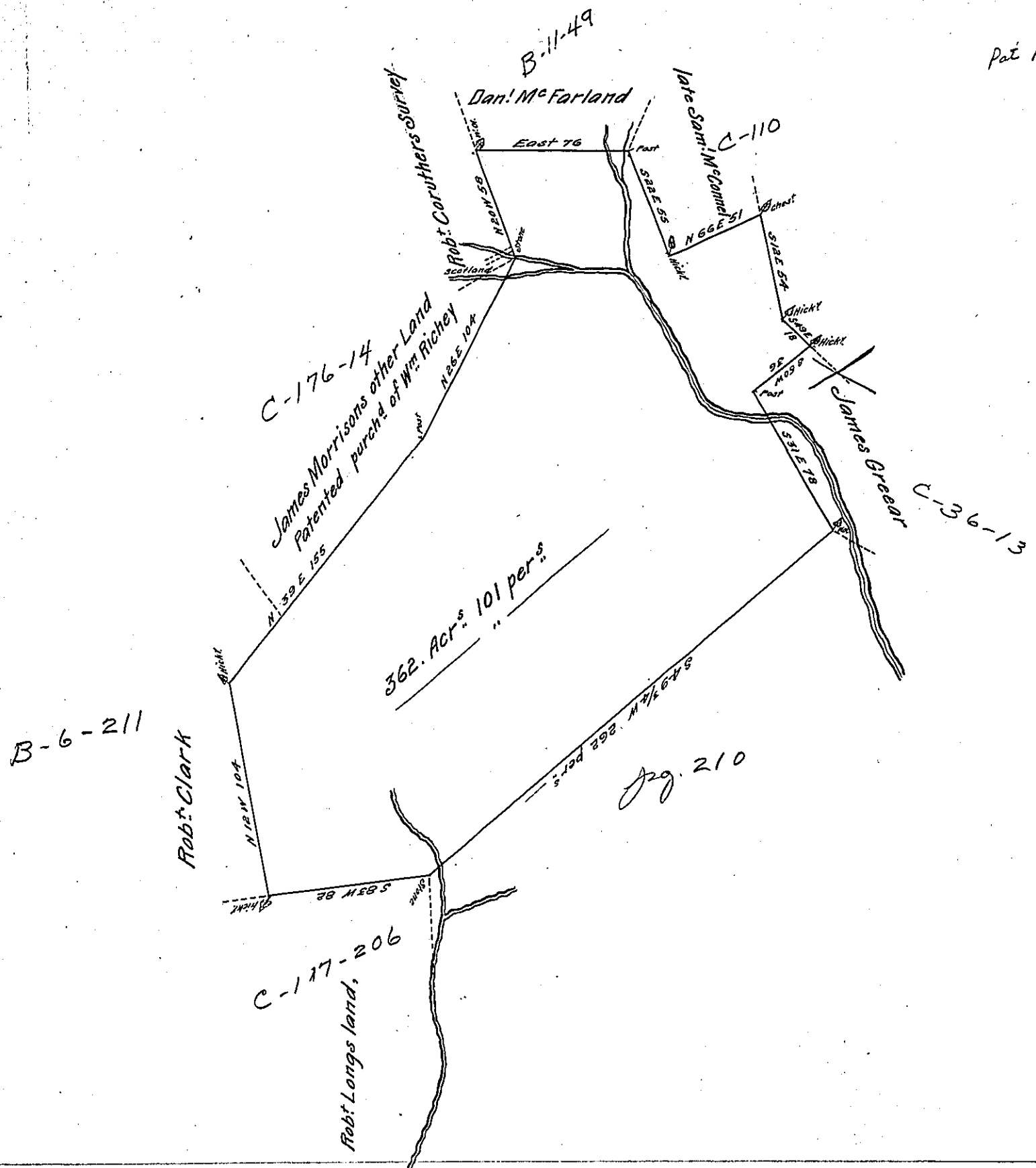

A Draught of 362 Acres 101 Perches and Allowance of Land situate in Drumore Township Lancaster County being part of several Tracts of Land, one thereof Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant dated 16 October 1741 granted to John Thompson for about 220 Acres &c., One other piece Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Daniel McConnel dated 22^d October 1745. One other Tract Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Elizabeth Morrison dated 2 July 1741 for 100 Acres, One other Tract on Warrant granted to James Gilchrist for about 77 Acres dated the 19th June 1741 - One other Tract on Warrant to James Steel dated 12th October 1745 for about 50 Acres, & One other Tract Surveyed in pursuance of two Warrants granted to Joseph Morrison one dated 21 May 1749 and the other 17th April 1752, which said above represented 362 Acres & 101 perches & All^{ce} is part of 740 Acres & Allowance
