



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the township of Greenwich and County of Berks, containing one hundred and twenty eight Acres and fifty seven and eight tenths Berches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. surveyed for John B. Baver, the twenty sixth day of March A.D. 1890. It being part of three larger tracts: one being one hundred and fifty Acres and thirty seven Berches and Allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated March 27, 1745, granted to Adam Simon Kuhn, fifty two Acres and one hundred and fifty five Berches and Allowance, originally surveyed on a Warrant granted to Morris Lawrence, dated March 8th 1750, and one hundred and ninety Acres and three quarters and Allowance, surveyed on a Warrant to Jacob Greenoble, dated January 4, 1749
