We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogenia & Ohio do hereby Certifie that Thomas Gist is intitled to four hundred acres of Land in this County on Gist run to include an Improvement made thereon in the year 1770 also a Right in Preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto Given under our hands at Cox's Fort the 4th day of Feby 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
