The yellow lines represent the survey made to Andrew Young in pursuance of two warrants one for 150^{ac} dated the 1st day of September 1772 and the other for 25^{ac} dated 20th Augt 1773. The red lines represent a survey made on a warrant to Edmund Mc Mahon dated the 21st day of May 1748. The part letter C. Containing 14 acres upon which there is no office right.
