



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the twenty ninth day of September A.D. 1849, and to me directed, I surveyed the thirteenth day of October, 1849, for Shiah Watson the above described Tract of Land, containing one hundred and thirty five Acres and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on the waters of ~~D. 1849~~ Cucumber Creek in Marsaw's Township, Jefferson County Pa. and bounded as follows viz: Beginning at an Old Cucumber, the South East corner of Tract No 3929, surveyed to Nichols and McPherson. Thence North along the line of said Tract ninety two perches to a post at R. Arthurs' South line. Thence East two hundred and forty eight perches to a post in Mill Creek. Thence South South ninety two perches and three hundred and twenty five hundredths of a perch along Warranted Lands of Tho's White and William Shaw to a post. Thence west two hundred and forty eight perches to the place of Beginning
