No 1 represented by the broken lines is a draft of a tract of land for Samuel Johnston the 16th day of August 1793 on Warrant dated the 30th day of August 1765— this tract Interferes Two hundred & seven Acres. and ninety eight perches with the Joseph Irvine tract— Samuel Johnston conveyed to George Woods whose heirs now Claim the land.

No 2 represented by Broken lines. is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Baldwin december the 4th 1765 —
In pursuance of A Warrant dated the 10th day of August 1765— This tract interferes Eleven Acres and thirty three perches With the Joseph Irvine tract— John Baldwin conveyed to John Baynton. Samuel Wharton & George Morgan to Richard Neave Senr & Richard Neave Jr who conveyed to Robert McKnight whose heirs now own the land —
