In pursuance of a Warrant for 150^a Granted to obliterated Everhart dated October 3^d 1785. The part *E* Originally Surveyed by the said Moses M^cClean late D.S. on the 18th day of June 1789. for Jacob Kerchner In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Moore for 50^a Dated February 12th 1789. The part *F* Surveyed on the 26th day of April 1804. In pursuance of a Warrant for 10^a Granted to Jacob Kerchner bearing date the 8th day of December Anno Domini 1803 Resurveyed &c on the 31st day of October & the 1st day of November Anno Domini 1808. at the particular Instant and Request of Jacob Kerchner the present Owner.
