"A" & "B" is two small tracts claimed by and surveyed for Benjamin Forsythe on two several Warrants granted to said Forsythe bearing date of the 13th February A.D. 1847, calling respectively for 20a. improved and 40a. unimproved land, and contains respectively 19a. 109.6P. and 33a. 20.9 P. and the usual allowance for Roads &c.*

Originally surveyed by David Redbeck Esq on an Application No 3509 (dated the 17th June 1769 of Moses Heskethall) on the 8th Decr 1783, and Surveyed by H. Hasleitt-Esq on the 15th day of May 1806 for John Gromly and Patented to him 26th Decr 1822, now owned by Samuel Large.
