The other part within the blue lines containing 8²⁵ 60 perches & allowance being a part of a tract of 75¹/₂ ac. of land originally surveyed for William Faris in pursuance of a warrant dated March 14th 1788 Resurveyed the above on the 9th day of March 1864 for Peter Zeigler the present owner who wishes to obtain a patent for the same.
