



A Draught of an Island situate in the river Susquehanna called "Presimon" Island about one mile below the Mouth of Conestogoe Creek, above Mondorfs Island & near another Island of the said Jacob Fehl and also near Brushy Island in the township of Conestogoe in the County of Lancaster. Containing thirteen Acres and One hundred & fifty six perches Neat Measure by Virtue of a warrant dated the 21<sup>st</sup> of December A.D. 1802 - Granted unto Jacob Fehl. June 18<sup>th</sup> 1812 - Surveyed the above Island at the request of the said Jacob Fehl -
