Sir - - - inclosed is a return of Survey - made to rectify an error in a former return occasioned by my assistant having inserted Archd instead of William in the draught - which error has been discovered in your office - it had escaped my notice - until upon examination I find the transferrance is handed down no further than to Wm Senr and Wm Junier in whose names it ought to have been returned - I have now altered the return so as to answer the purpose I hope - And would just remark that Wm. Gardner Senr is dead - I mention it - in Order that proper measures may be taken to Secure his right to his proper heirs - with the least trouble - to prevent the impropriety of granting to the deceased
