



A Draught of Two tracts of Land Situate part in Latimore Township Adams County and part in Middleton Township Cumberland County Surv^d as follows to Wit —
 John Love 353⁹⁵ 147 ps. and allowance, Surveyed the 7th Day of October 1794. to the said John Love in pursuance of a warrant dated the 4th Jan^y 1794. — George Brandon 128⁹ 105 ps and allowance, Surveyed October 17th 1806. by Sam^l Sloan D.S. of Adams County to said Geo. Brandon in pursuance of a warrant dated the 3^d day of September 1743.

Agreeable to an order of the Board of Property dated the 7th day of April 1807 Directing the D.S. of the proper district to Lay down the Claims of the parties with the dates of the Several Surveys &c In Compliance wherewith I went on the ground to ascertain and Lay down the Claims of the parties. — But being prevented by John Love, he would not allow me to run the Lines — I have Laid down the Claims of the parties as Surveyed by Sam^l Lyon D.S. and Sam^l Sloan D.S. of Adams County. — The ^{part Colored} Yellow represents the Land in Dispute Between John Love and Abraham Thompson in right of Geo. Brandon.

The Board afterwards viz on the 7 day of Dec^r 1807 decided in favour of Brandons Warrant for the piece in Yellow, which was not known when the inclosed Survey was accepted.
