



The above is a Draught of a Survey, made June 29th 1827, for the Administrators of Wm Hawkins Esq Decd, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Edward Gaiter, for 60 Acres of land, situate on the Waters of Buffalo Creek, Dated Sept^r 7th 1786^{containing 105 acres +} - It appears from documents in my possession, that a Survey was made on the above land, June 2^d 1787, (said to be put on the rejected file) - It also appears that the part now Returned, (embraced by the black lines), was Conveyed by Edward Gaiter, to Henry and Jacob Goss, and by Goss, to Wm Hawkins Esq Decd, Containing thirty five Acres and fifty three perch and Allow-
 ance of six per Cent for highways, situate in Donegall Township, W. C., ^{on the water of Buffalo Creek} the improvement appears to be as old as the warrant - the part on the N.W. end embraced by the Dotted lines was Conveyd by Edward Gaiter, to Arthur Hagans, and James Brown, - The part at the S. E. end represented by dotted lines inter-
 fered, and is Cut off by other lands of Wm Hawkins
